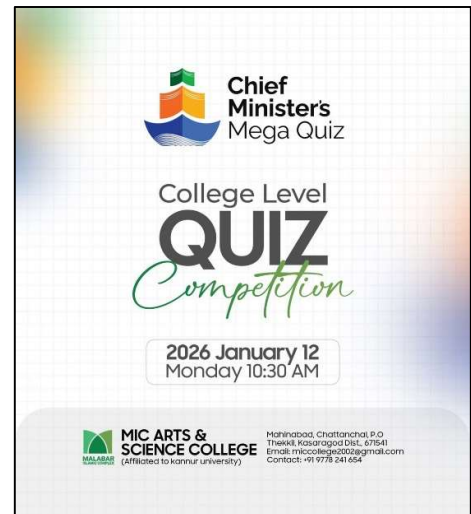
## Fine Arts 2026 – Off-Stage Competitions

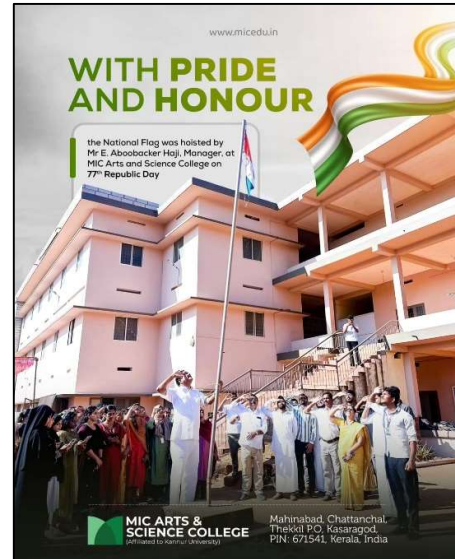
DeepLearning Technolab developed the mobile app exclusively for the Fine Arts programme of MIC.

The programme was conducted across three different stages, each showcasing a variety of art forms.



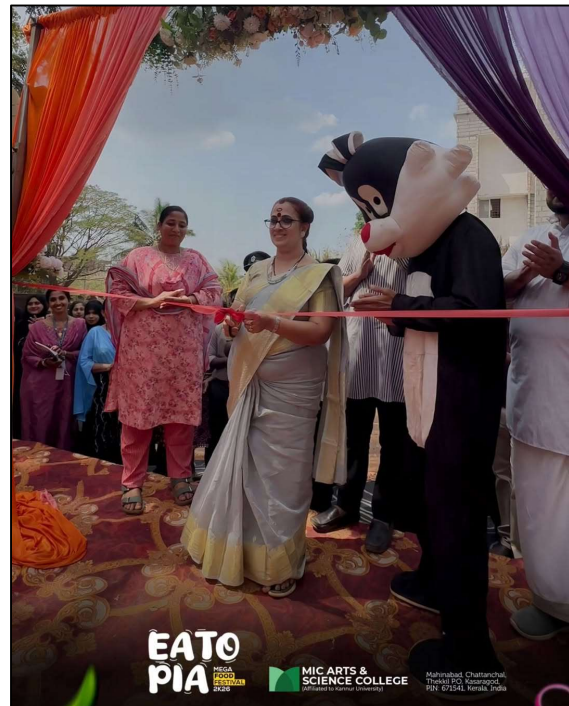
### Republic Day Celebration

### Eatopia '26 – Food Festival

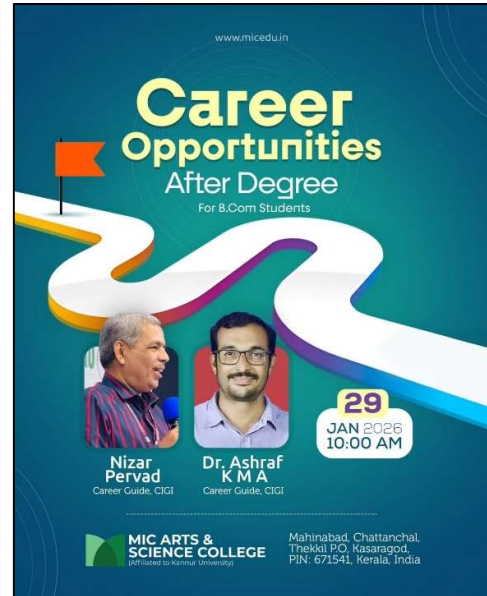
