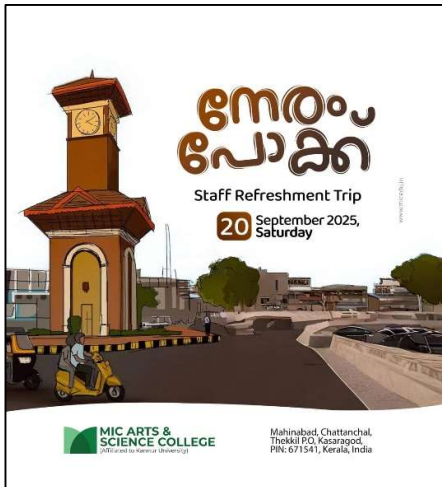
ED Club Formation

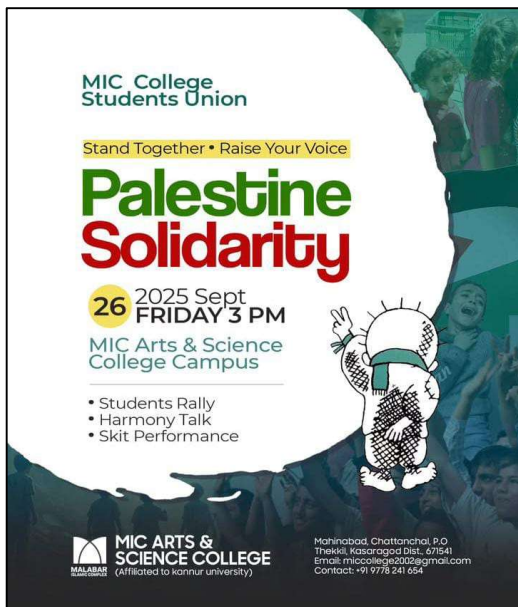
Placement Drive

Palestine Solidarity Rally

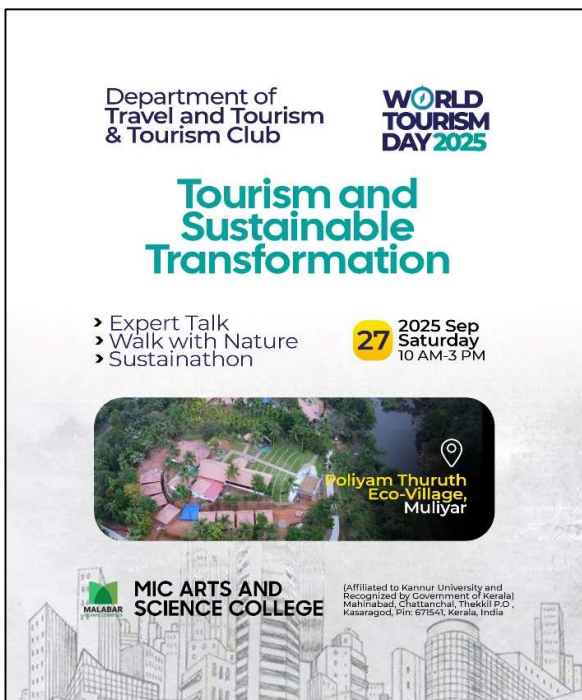
